THE GROVE OREWA OFFERS A RANGE OF RESIDENT CARE SERVICES

When you move into The Grove Orewa it's because you want to continue to live your life as independently as you ever have, but in the knowledge that should your circumstances change, there will be care at hand.

The Grove Orewa, in partnership with The Selwyn Foundation, offers independent-living residents the assurance of on-site care services, which can be accessed as you need them.

To start with, it might just be help with some of the small day-to-day tasks such as shopping or transport, but in the event that you develop health issues that affect your ability to live independently, a comprehensive range of health services will also be available.

It means that when you move into The Grove Orewa, you can stay in your home as long as possible.

INTRODUCING THE SELWYN FOUNDATION

In thinking about best-practice care services for our residents, we have elected to partner with an established operator in the aged-care sector.

The Selwyn Foundation is a charitable organisation dedicated to serving older people and their families.

They established one of New Zealand's first retirement villages, Selwyn Village in Pt Chevalier in 1954, and since then have expanded the number of villages throughout Auckland and beyond.

As well as its own villages, The Selwyn Foundation also has a range of health and wellbeing services for older people living in the community. These are a combination of technology-based monitoring and home-visit services.

ACCESS AND MOBILITY

All accessways in the village, whether they are inside the apartments or within the common areas, have been designed with future mobility needs in mind. You can move through the village and your apartment without having to navigate stairs. All doorways are wide enough to accommodate wheelchairs. All showers have a wide unrestricted entry and can be converted for disabled access. All kitchens can be modified for use by those in wheelchairs.

SELWYN CARE COORDINATOR

The Selwyn Care Coordinator is your (or your family's) first port of call if your health situation changes. Often the hardest thing to do is work out what you need, who can provide it, and if you are entitled to funding or not. Instead of phoning multiple different organisations you can now phone our Care Coordinator. They'll work closely with The Grove team to provide advice and help to set up a specific plan of care services for you.

OUR SERVICES

Take it easy

Includes some basic day-to-day services such as assistance with transport, shopping and housekeeping. Also includes access to a state-of-the-art strength & exercise programme and health services co-ordinator.

Helping hand

The same as the 'Take it easy' service, but with additional support in the areas of personal care, meals and access to a registered nurse.

Supported care

For greater support across day-to-day living and health / medical management.

The following is an indication of the services that are available to residents of The Grove Orewa.

TAKE IT EASY PACKAGE

This is designed for those residents who simply want to take life a little easier. It includes:

Service	Frequency	Cost
Health and well-being screening by Selwyn staff	On arrival	\$235 per week (GST inclusive)
Health navigator service and support	Maximum 3 per annum	
Fortnightly nurse clinic	As required	
Housework, laundry	1 per week, minimum 1 hour	
HUR strength programme	1 per week	
Evening meal	Daily	
Rubbish removal from apartment	Weekly	

HELPING HAND PACKAGE

This has been designed for those needing a little more of a helping hand. It includes everything above plus:

Service	Frequency	Cost
Lunch and dinner	Daily	\$395 per week (GST inclusive)
Registered Nurse (RN) assessment	1 per month	
Morning support / personal care	Daily	
Falls prevention	Every 3 months	

SUPPORTED CARE PACKAGE

This has been designed for those residents who need full services in their own homes. It includes everything above plus:

Service	Frequency	Cost
RN health assessment / virtual consultation	2 per week	\$650 per week (GST inclusive)
Medication management	Daily	
Morning & evening assistance	Daily	

ONE OFF SERVICES

These can be provided on a needs basis, either individually or to be incorporated into a package:

Service	Frequency	Cost
Post-event assessment / medical services coordinator	As required	\$200
Telemonitoring programme	12-week programme	\$1,275
Companionship visits	As required	\$26 per half hour
Medication management	Daily	\$100 per week
Outside walking support	As required	\$26 per half hour
Any extra meals as required	As required: must be pre-booked	Pricing available at reception
In-person visits by Registered Nurse	As required	\$45
Housekeeping / personal care and support	As required: minimum half hour	\$26 per half hour

Please note that specific medical equipment, telemonitoring and/or rehabilitation services are available and charged on a case-by-case basis. Any consumables used during consults are also charged to residents.
